MATCH BRIEFING

COLD RANGE: Greater Pittsburgh Gun Club is a cold range. If you should arrive at the range with a carry gun, you must immediately find a Range Officer to clear the weapon and put it in your bag. The gun will then be returned to your vehicle.

SAFETY AREAS: Firearms can only be managed at a safe table. There will be no bagging/unbagging of handguns permitted from your vehicle. PCCs may be bagged/unbagged at the vehicles if flagged and managed in a safe manner (muzzle up or down). All gun handling must take place at a safe table or under the direction of a Range Officer. As a reminder, handling of ammunition at the safe table is not permitted. This will result in a match disqualification. PCCs may be managed within two yards of the side berms and on gun racks.

EYE & HEARING PROTECTION:

While on the range, competitors and spectators must always wear eye and hearing protection.

FIRST AID: If you are having difficulties or need assistance, please let a Range Officer know.

SET STEEL & TAPE TARGETS:

Competitors are expected to tape targets and set steel.

MATCH SCORING: The match will be scored using PractiScore. Score logging will be enabled and emails sent for receipts. Scores will be posted regularly during the match, at least at the lunch break and when done for the day.

STAGE WALK-THROUGHS: If no competitors are shooting on Friday, preparing to shoot, or scoring the stage, registered competitors may enter or move through the course of fire. On Saturday and Sunday, competitors may only enter or move through the course of fire with prior approval of either the Range Master or the Range Officer assigned to that stage. No activated targets may be managed or manipulated during stage walk-throughs.

LOST BRASS: As a matter of efficiency, all brass is for staff to collect.



RANGE FACILITIES

CLUB HOUSE: Apart from shooter registration and lunch, the clubhouse will be off-limits to competitors. Only select staff are permitted to enter the clubhouse.

RESTROOMS: Portable restrooms are located conveniently throughout the range.

FOOD SERVICE: Lunch will be determined on the day of the match. Food will be available for competitors to purchase. Picnic tables will be located outside the clubhouse.

PARKING: Parking is anywhere in the grassy fields near the bays or surrounding areas.



A test bay is available for competitor gun issues. Competitors must have permission from the Range Master to use this bay.









Jerseys will be available for \$45 in limited sizes and quantities



START POSITION: Both feet touching mark. Handgun loaded and holstered, wrists below belt. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On the audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area. Popper 1 activates max trap, which remains visible at rest.

SCORING: Comstock, 24 Rounds, 120 Points

TARGETS: 11 USPSA, 2 steel












Is This the Place of My Undoing?



START POSITION: Both feet touching mark. Handgun loaded and holstered, wrists below belt. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On the audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area. Popper 2 activates double swinger, which remains visible at rest.


SCORING: Comstock, 23 Rounds, 115 Points

TARGETS: 10 IPSC, 3 steel





King of Deception



START POSITION: Both feet touching mark. Handgun unloaded and holstered, wrists below belt. PCC is unloaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On the audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area. Popper 1 activates swinger 1. Popper 2 activates swinger 2. Both remain visible at rest.

SCORING: Comstock, 20 Rounds, 100 Points

TARGETS: 9 USPSA, 2 steel










Beyond the Horizon Again



START POSITION: Both feet touching either mark. Handgun loaded and holstered, wrists below belt. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On the audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area. Popper 1 activates swinger, which remains visible at rest.


SCORING: Comstock, 31 Rounds, 155 Points

TARGETS: 14 IPSC, 3 steel





Of the Abyss



START POSITION: Both feet touching mark. Handgun loaded and holstered, wrists below belt. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On the audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area. Popper 1 activates bobber, which remains visible at rest.


SCORING: Comstock, 19 Rounds, 95 Points

TARGETS: 9 USPSA, 1 steel












...And I Return to Nothingness



START POSITION: Standing anywhere inside the shooting area, wrists above shoulders. Firearm is loaded, flat on table, trigger guard over mark, barrel directly down range.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On the audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area. Popper 3 activates sliding swinger, which remains visible at rest.


SCORING: Comstock, 28 Rounds, 140 Points

TARGETS: 12 IPSC, 4 steel





This Lucid Dream Lingers Onward



START POSITION: Both feet touching mark. Handgun loaded and holstered, wrists below belt. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On the audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area. Popper 2 activates sliding poppers, which remain visible at rest.

SCORING: Comstock, 24 Rounds, 120 Points

TARGETS: 10 USPSA, 4 steel









I Lift My Head and All is Born Again



START POSITION: Standing anywhere inside the shooting area, facing down range. Handgun loaded and holstered, wrists below belt. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On the audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area. Popper 1 activates swinger 1. Popper 2 activates swinger 2. Both remain visible at rest.


SCORING: Comstock, 31 Rounds, 155 Points

TARGETS: 14 IPSC, 3 steel





Welcome Back, O' Sleeping Dreamer



START POSITION: Both feet touching either mark. Handgun loaded and holstered, wrists below belt. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt.


STAGE PROCEDURE: On the audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area. The last 3 targets engaged must **ONLY** be engaged **STRONG HAND ONLY**. Popper 1 activates swinger, which remains visible at rest.

SCORING: Comstock, 27 Rounds, 135 Points

TARGETS: 13 IPSC, 1 steel











After All I've Done, I'll Disappear



START POSITION: Both hands flat on marks. Handgun loaded and holstered. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt, muzzle touching mark.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On the audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area.

SCORING: Comstock, 25 Rounds, 125 Points

TARGETS: 11 USPSA, 3 steel
